A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATIONS MEASURE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING 30 JUNE 2020 AND THE TAX LEVY AND RATES.

A resolution adopted by the Grand Ledge Area Emergency Services Authority board, at a regular meeting held on Monday May 18, 2020 in an online teleconference, in compliance with State of Michigan Executive Order No. 2020-75., Grand Ledge, Michigan.

WHEREAS, the Grand Ledge Area Emergency Services Authority (GLAESA), is a public body corporate organized under the provisions of Public Act 57 of 1988, and is governed by the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation and By Laws adopted October 16, 2001; and

WHEREAS, Public Act 621 of 1978, entitled the Uniform Budgeting and Accounting Act, provides for a system of uniform procedures to guide the preparation and execution of budgets in all local units of government in the state of Michigan; and

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2020, a Public Hearing was held in accordance with Public Act 621 of 1978;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Annual Budget and Appropriations Measure for the Fiscal Year Ending 30 June 2021 is adopted, as follows:
 - General Operating and Debt Service Expenditures of \$1,772,002.92
 - Revenue Funds Appropriation from Millage, EMS and other revenue sources, for Expenditures, of \$1,772,002.92

The Grand Ledge Area Emergency Services Authority levied a millage renewal on November 8, 2016 of 3 mills (\$3.00 on each \$1000.00 of taxable value) against all properties in the City of Grand Ledge, Eaton County, Michigan for emergency services authority operations for a period of five (5) years, 2018 through 2022, inclusive, as required by the Headlee Amendment to the Michigan Constitution of 1963, with Millage Reduction Fraction of 1.0000 thus making the maximum allowable millage rate of 2.9468 raising an estimated \$672,581.00

The Grand Ledge Area Emergency Services Authority levied a millage renewal on November 8, 2016 against all properties in the Township of Oneida, Eaton County, Michigan, for emergency services authority operations of 3 mills (\$3.00 on each \$1000.00 of taxable value) for a period of five (5) years, 2018 through 2022 inclusive, as required by the Headlee Amendment to the Michigan Constitution of 1963, with Millage Reduction Fraction of 1.0000 thus making the allowable millage rate of 2.9468, raising an estimated \$482,394.00
