Discussion - Chief Mike Roman explained that the grant program requires a resolution by the Authority Board as part of the grant process, and that the application is due on September 15th. Due to absences in the following week, this requirement is the primary reason for holding the special meeting: to seek approval of a resolution to apply for safety equipment. The allowable grant amount is \$5,000, and the equipment requested would outfit GLAESA responders with Ultrabright Safety Fire Vests and Guardian Angel Micro Safety Lights. The vests meet National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) standards for reflectivity. This equipment is intended to enhance personnel safety and improve scene visibility.

Rich Lantz questioned the language in the resolution referencing "Michigan Township," but later determined that the term is used interchangeably and acceptable as written. The total cost of the equipment outlined in the resolution is just under the \$5,000 maximum allowed by the grant. A roll call vote was conducted at 1909, and all present members voted **YES** to approve the resolution.

XI. **Communications from Authority Board members.**

Chief Mike Roman added comments, noting that the building committee met earlier this morning. He reported it was a productive two-hour meeting and expressed enthusiasm about the direction of the project. The building committee team will attend the September 21st meeting to present a timeline and discuss financial considerations.

Don Willems asked whether there had been any discussion regarding Oneida Charter Township's potential rebuilding of its garage. Chief Mike Roman stated that he would prefer Jan Schultz to address that question, but in her absence he shared his understanding that the Township is currently tabling the idea. Chief Roman also noted that the location of the Township Hall is significant. In response to Rick Lantz's question about why that location matters, Chief Roman explained that from an ISO rating perspective, the Township Hall site benefits certain geographical areas that the proposed new station location would not. Don Willems added that Township voters are an important priority and the board wants to continue hearing and supporting their needs.

Chief Mike Roman provided an additional update on his work toward making Grand Ledge a heart-safe community. He continues collaborating with Laura Guild, founder of **The Ev Effect**, a foundation established in memory of her son who passed away from sudden cardiac arrest at the Grand Ledge High School. Chief Roman expressed interest in pursuing the development of a 501(c)(3) structure for donations related to this initiative, acknowledging that the process is complex and will require legal guidance. The board agreed. Robert Stahelin noted that the Everson Guild event is personally meaningful to him and emphasized that AEDs, paired with proper training, are exactly what is needed. Chief Roman further added that he has been working with Eaton County 911 to incorporate AED location data into real-time emergency responses to improve deployment effectiveness.

Total Project Budget: \$110,000.00

The Truck Committee recommends purchasing a Chevrolet Silverado 3500HD Work Truck with a crew cab, standard bed, gasoline engine, four-wheel drive and single rear wheels. The Chevrolet provides the best combination of price, equipment capacity, maneuverability, factory options and future usefulness.

Price Comparison



Vehicle	Price	Remaining Project Budget
Chevrolet Silverado 3500HD	\$57,735.00	\$52,265.00
Ford F-350 XL	\$60,105.00	\$49,895.00
Ram 3500 Tradesman Long Box	\$71,380.00	\$38,620.00

The Chevrolet saves **\$2,370.00 over the Ford** and **\$13,645.00 over the Ram**, leaving the most funding available for emergency-vehicle upfitting.

The Ford would also require an additional bed liner because one is unavailable with the quoted model and package. Neither the Ford nor the Ram includes steps comparable to the industrial/commercial-rated steps included with the Chevrolet.

Project Budget and Upfitting

The additional upfitting costs are tracking within the amounts anticipated during the budgeting process. The Truck Committee is confident that the completed truck can be purchased and upfitted at or below the **\$110,000.00 total project budget**. Initial estimates are below budget price with a margin for error that is acceptable to meet budget goals.

Final upfitting quotes are expected next month. However, those quotes cannot be completed until the Board selects the truck chassis. The manufacturer and model directly affect:

- Emergency and scene-lighting placement
- Electrical components, wiring and load requirements
- Radio and communications equipment installation

- Center-console design and fit
- Bed storage and equipment configurations
- Skid-unit and storage-box placement

The upfitter must know the cab design, electrical system, bed dimensions and factory equipment before completing an accurate quote. Selecting the Chevrolet chassis now will allow the vendors to finish the design and provide final pricing while remaining within the approved budget.

Operational Advantages

The Chevrolet's 82.25-inch standard bed provides enough space for the existing skid unit, storage boxes, hose, saws and tools. The Ram short box is only 76.3 inches long and is not large enough for the department's equipment.

The Ram would therefore require an eight-foot bed, making it approximately 260.8 inches long compared with 250 inches for the Chevrolet. The added length could create problems inside the station and during operations on narrow roads, driveways and confined emergency scenes.

The Chevrolet also provides:

- A 6.6-liter gasoline V8 producing 464 pound-feet of torque
- A 10-speed automatic transmission
- A 36-gallon fuel tank
- A manageable 52.7-foot turning diameter
- Industrial/commercial-rated steps included in the quote
- Future snowplow and medical first-response capability

Required Factory Packages

The Truck Committee reviewed MI-Deal purchasing options; however, the available configurations did not include the required combination of higher-output alternator, snowplow-preparation package and spring configuration.

These factory options are necessary to support the skid unit, water, equipment, emergency lighting, scene lighting, radios and charging equipment. Purchasing a truck without them could complicate the upfit, limit future snowplow capability or require additional electrical and suspension modifications.

Ordering the correct configuration initially is more practical and financially responsible than modifying an inadequately equipped truck after delivery.

Local Purchase

The Chevrolet can be purchased locally through Sundance Chevrolet. A local purchase provides easier coordination of the factory order, delivery, warranty service, parts and upfitting requirements. It also gives the department a nearby point of contact throughout the truck's service life while supporting a local business.

Need for Prompt Authorization

The current model year is ending, and changes are expected for the Chevrolet 3500 line with the 2027 model year. If the truck is not ordered promptly, the selected configuration may no longer be available.

Waiting for the 2027 model could also delay the project while upfitters obtain compatible lighting mounts, wiring information, consoles, bed components and other model-specific parts. Selecting and ordering the chassis now will allow the upfitting quotes to be finalized and reduce the risk of higher costs or delayed delivery.

Recommendation

The Truck Committee recommends that the Board:

1. Select the Chevrolet Silverado 3500HD as the chassis for the new brush truck.
2. Authorize its purchase through Sundance Chevrolet for **\$57,735.00 MSRP**.
3. Allow the Truck Committee to complete the final upfitting design and quotes within the approved **\$110,000.00 total project budget**.

The Chevrolet is the lowest-priced option, includes valuable commercial equipment, provides sufficient bed space and can be ordered with the electrical, suspension and plow-preparation packages required by the department.

For these reasons, the Chevrolet Silverado 3500HD is the most practical, operationally appropriate and financially responsible choice.

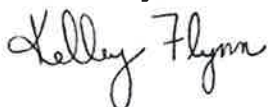
